LACED VASE








The vase is turned from any suitable wood, Lime, Beech, Sycamore for example.

The eyelets can be sourced on ebay see below and are available is a variety of sizes and colours, I normally use the 7mm size.



The waxed cord is also available on line in a variety of sizes, I usually use either 2mm or 3mm black waxed cord.









For Iridescent paints:

Apply black base coat (or two) and allow to dry.

Apply iridescent colours.

If required using a sponge / brush / bubble wrap or tool of choice start with one colour and work over the surface starting at the edge, if required continue and integrate the next colour in. Allow it to blend if you don't want to see stop start marks. Continue until you have covered the entire surface.

Allow to dry.

The drying of the base coat of paint and crackle layer can be speeded up with a gentle hairdryer. Preferably the top coat must be left to dry naturally.

If you wish to speed up the drying time for the top layer, you can use the hairdryer,

If using crackle the time between putting the décor crackle on and applying the top coat is recommended as 'up to 6 hours' when drying naturally, but it has worked for up to a week and the crackle has still worked

You will get a different crackle effect according to how you apply the top paint. A sponge will give you a random crackle, a brush will give you a bark effect.

Finally give a spray finish of Acyclic gloss if required.
